Awakening Path

- Option to become an Intern Member of HIA

Certified Healer Path

You are called to add Energy Healing to your current work or you desire to become a practicing Certified Energy Healer with the support of a National Organization.

- Attend Certified Energy Healer Training Parts 1, 2 and 3 with support of two mentors
- Join as an Intern Member by completing the application process
- Maintain Intern Log Book recording experience practicing Energy Healing
- Familiarize self with HIA Code of Ethics
- Attend Energy Healing practice sessions
- Work on clients to precede Certification
- Take certification exam on Code of Ethics and demonstration of Energy Healing (in person or via Skype)
- Purchase liability insurance

Certified Trainer or Assistant Trainer Path

You are a Certified Energy Healer with teaching skills and wish to develop as HIA Trainer or to assist HIA Certified Trainers.

- Repeat Certified Energy Healer Training Parts 1, 2 and 3
- Attend HIA Teachers Training Parts 1 and 2
- Apprentice and share cost with local or regional trainers until approved to run Certified Energy Healing Training Parts 1, 2 and 3 independently

Certified Regional Executive Path

You are a Certified Energy Healer with a desire to help expand the HIA vision with a proven market developer with experience in sales and marketing.

- Regional market development in churches, hospitals, physician practices, hospices, etc
- Develop both national & regional speaking engagements, sponsors/supporters
- Assist and approve Certified Trainers for local markets
- Regional responsibilities
